Online Open Tender (Indigenous Tender) in two bid system are invited for Software Development, Migration and Implementation of Single Commercial System For EXIM & Domestic Logistics Business of CONCOR Along with other Modules For Integration with other Govt. Systems And Onsite Support/ Maintenance of the System **only through e-tendering mode.**

1. The bid document can only be downloaded from the website (www.tenderwizard.com/CCIL) and the intending bidders should submit the document sale price of ₹ 1,000.00 inclusive of all taxes and duties **through e-payment at the time of making online request.**
2. Complete tender papers duly accompanied with requisite EMD shall be received online as per date and time mentioned below and may be opened in presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives.

Minimum annual turnover	The average annual turnover of the bidder or consortium during the last three financial years should not be less than ₹ 7,29,13,340.95. In case of consortium*, the average annual turnover shall be determined by adding together the average annual turnover of all the partners. However, the lead partner must have at least 60% of the minimum average annual turnover mentioned above.
Experience with respect to similar nature works	The bidder should have experience in design/ development/ implementation/ Support/ migration/support of software similar to that of CONCOR's requirement. The minimum amount of single work of the similar nature should be amounting to ₹ 9,18,90,785.85 or works of similar nature amounting to ₹ 13,78,36,178.78 during previous 84 months prior to the date of tender opening.

In case of consortium*, the experience in this case shall be determined by adding together the experience of all the partners, however, the lead partner must have at least 60% of the minimum experience mentioned above.

In this regard, out of these orders the vendor should have executed order for the following either in the same order or in separate orders:

i. Same Domain experience

The bidder should have executed one order for Container logistics/ Rail-Road/ Warehousing/ Port industry.

ii. Centralized System and multilocation Experience

The bidder should have successfully designed, developed, implemented multilocation centralized system and successfully running at least at 10 locations for two years.

iii. Migration Experience

The bidder should have executed the orders for migration/support/implementation of software with RDBMS mentioned below at 'a' or 'b', depending upon the RDBMS proposed for the software for CONCOR:

a) Proposed RDBMS for similar to existing i.e. Oracle

In case the bidder is proposing RDBMS of application same as that of existing i.e. Oracle, then the bidder should have executed at least one order of migration/ support (for multi-location and centralized system) to the proposed RDBMS i.e. Oracle.

b) Proposed RDBMS other than the existing i.e. Oracle

In case bidder is proposing any Other RDBMS other than the existing i.e. Oracle, then the bidder should have executed at least one order of migration of database from the Oracle to the proposed RDBMS and order for support of such application for multi-location and centralized system. These orders (i.e. migration and support) can be either in the same order or in two separate orders.

The above mentioned details should be supported by copy of Purchase orders along with the completion certificate indicating



	completion of such activities i.e. design/ development/ implementation/ Support/ migration. For Support /on-going services (separate orders or combined with supply/implementation/migration order), value of each completed year would be considered. The experience of the consortium partner shall also be considered; however, the lead partner must have at least 60% of the works executed in terms of value.
Certification	Bidder should be ISO 27001:2013 certified (or its latest version) OR CMM Level-3 (or above) or ISO:9001:2008 certified (or its latest version)
Support	The bidder should have office in Delhi/NCR.

*Constitution of Consortium:

One of the members of the Consortium shall be the lead member who shall have an at least 60% share of interest in it. Other members of Consortium shall have at least 15% (fifteen per cent) stake each.

3. CONCOR reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

To participate in the E-Bid submission, it is mandatory for the bidders to have user ID & password which has to be obtained by submitting an annual registration charges of INR 1500/- plus taxes as applicable to M/s.
