- On 29th May, 2019 CONCOR received the prestigious award as the winner in the "Transport & Logistics Category" at the Duns & Bradstreet Corporate Awards function, held at Hotel Trident, Nariman Point, Mumbai.
- On 7th July, 2019 CONCOR received the Container Terminal Operator of the year award in South-East Cargo & Logistics Award 2019 at Chennai.
- On 6th September, 2019 GGM, Southern Region received State Award from Karnataka, Chief Ministers for Service Sector at Vidhana Soudha, Bangalore.
- CONCOR won the prestigious Delhi Best Employer Brand Awards 2019 presented by Zee Business.
- On 27th September, 2019 CONCOR won The Gateway Awards 2019 in the category "Inland Container Depot of the year.
- On 29th November, 2019 CONCOR was awarded the Punjab Logistic Leadership Awards 2019 at Taj Chandigarh, Chandigarh.
- On 12th December, 2019 CONCOR won the prestigious CII SCALE Awards 2019 in the category "Container Logistics" at Hotel Taj, Bangalore.
- On 17th January, 2020 CONCOR won the Northern India Multimodal Logistics Award 2020 in the category Inland Container Depot & Rail Operator of the year.
- On 7th February, 2020 CONCOR received "Company of the year- Logistics" Award from CNBC-AWAAZ for outstanding performance & consistently excelling on parameters such as growth, capital efficiency and profitability held at Raipur.
- On 16th February, 2020 received ET Now Business Leader of the year Award in the category – Best State of the Art Facility held at Mumbai.

NEW DEVELOPMENTS DURING THE YEAR

- On 3rd April, 2019, first Import loaded container cargo received at CONCOR's Subsidiary, FHEL. The cargo was destuffed and kept in Bonded Cold storage Warehouse at FHEL Rai, Sonipat. This is a big facility for farm to table Import Cargo, will bring down overall Logistics Cost for Trade.
- On 7th April, 2019 CONCOR received the first automobile train at its Durgapur Terminal of Eastern Region.
- On 3rd May, 2019 CONCOR's new Domestic Container Terminal at Khodiyar was inaugurated having Rail Siding, Container yard, three modern warehouses, etc. This terminal is a Multi-Modal Logistics Hub to cater to the needs of Commercial/Industrial city of Ahmedabad & surroundings.
- On 15th July, 2019 CONCOR started Air Cargo handling of Un - accompanied Baggage Cargo (UBC) from Goa Airport. Commencement of this new facility is a landmark achievement in CONCOR's commitment for customer value creation.
- On 12th August, 2019 Suranussi land license agreement was signed at Ferozepur Division between Director International Marketing & Operations /CONCOR (DIMO)

and other senior officers from Railways and from 14th August, 2019 container train operations commenced from Suranussi located near Jalandhar in Ferozepur Division of Northern Railways.

- On 30th August, 2019 first train of full export container rake M/s. KEC International Limited was flagged off at ICD, Nagpur by CGM/Central Region CONCOR in presence of Dy. Commissioner, Customs & Officials of M/s. KEC International Limited in association with Goodrich Logistics Private Limited & Thaparsons KV.
- On 31st August, 2019 maiden train service to Katupalli Port from ICD/Whitefield/ CONCOR via TNPM connecting HMM vessel was flagged off.
- On 4th September, 2019 inaugural Truck Service for evacuation of Import Containers Ex-Katupalli Port to ICD, Whitefield via ICD, Tondiarpet was flagged off by Executive Director, Southern Region, CONCOR.
- On 5th September, 2019 inaugural Train Service of Import Containers at Ex-Katupalli Port, Whitefield, Bangalore was flagged off by GGM CONCOR, Southern Region and Customs Officials.
- On 11th September, 2019 CONCOR commissioned Pipavav Integrated Logistics Hub (PILH), a Multi-Modal Logistics facility by Joint Working Group formed by CONCOR & CWC.
- On 18th September, 2019 modern warehouse was inaugurated in Majerhat Terminal (CTKR) Eastern Region, CONCOR.
- On 25th September, 2019 CONCOR inaugurated the first scheduled block rake from BMCT/ PSA to CONCOR, ICD/TKD.
- On 6th October, 2019 First Export train from MMLP, Atal Nagar (Naya Raipur) to Vishakhapatnam was flagged by Terminal Manager, Raipur & Superintendent/Customs.
- On 22nd October, 2019 CONCOR's new ultra-short haul Round Trips rail service between J.N. Port & Dronagiri Rail Terminal inaugurated by Sh. D.K. Singh, COM Central Railways. This will help in decongest the port and shall facilitate trade & industry in a big way.
- On 30th October, 2019 Satarkta Express flagged off by CVO/CONCOR from CONCOR DCT Okhla on account of Vigilance Awareness Week.
- On 4th January, 2020 CONCOR ICD/Kota dispatched the first complete BLC rakes to Pune Chinchwad carrying Bulk Wheat Grains in heavy duty containers.
- ON 22nd January, 2020 inaugural train service of postal containers from ICD/Vallarpadam to ICD/Whitefield was flagged off by CONCOR Executive Director/ Southern Region, Dr. Beena, IAS, Chairperson, Cochin Port Trust & DP World India Officials.
- On 25th January, 2020 CONCOR/South Central Region started the reefer movement between Tadipatri and JNPT. The anticipated traffic is approximately 25 rakes in three months. Empty reefer containers are being unloaded at Tadipatri CRT locations on GTL Division, where CONCOR created a full-fledged facility with reefer points, power back-up etc., from the scratch.
- On 1st February, 2020 CONCOR handled the first BCN rake at CONCOR siding, Mangalore.

- On 13th February, 2020 first export container rake from CONCOR/Multi Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) Mihan, Nagpur carrying consignment of M/s. KEC International Ltd. was flagged off by CONCOR/CGM Central Region in the presence of Sh. H.R. Bheema Shankar/ Chief Commissioner Customs and other senior officers.
- On 25th March, 2020 CONCOR's first Happy Banana Reefer Container rake successfully arrived at JNPT today without any hitch enroute, in less than 60 hours (including power interception at Daund and ghat operation in Lonavala-Karjat section) covering 867 Kms.
- During the month i.e. March'20, 58 rakes were loaded and dispatched to ICD Birgunj (IDBR) from MMLP Vishakhapatnam (CCJS) / Vishakhapatnam Port (VCTPL) put together and 17 rakes were loaded and dispatched to ICD Birgunj (IDBR) from Kolkata Port (KoPT) i.e. total 75 rakes were loaded which is the best ever record of loading for ICD Birgunj (IDBR).
- ICD Birgunj (IDBR) terminal unloaded 70 rakes during the month i.e. March'20 despite several constraints which is also the best ever performance for ICD Birgunj (IDBR).
- MMLP Vishakhapatnam (CCJS) loaded 63 rakes outward trains during the month i.e. March'20 which is also the best ever performance figure for MMLP Vishakhapatnam (CCJS).
