Sub: - Open e-Tender in Two Bid System for Friction Wedge as per RDSO specification no. CONTR-02-MISC-2007 or Latest.

This has reference to e-tender notice no. CON/T/BLCM/Friction-Wedge/2020 published on 01.10.2020

Prospective bidders may kindly note that in the above mentioned tender document, the following Amendments have been made:

Clause No.	New/Amended
New Clause 26.0 of Section-II	Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India)
New Clause 26.1 of Section-II	Only 'Class-I local supplier' and 'Class-II local supplier', as defined under the order, shall be eligible to bid in procurements undertaken by procuring entities, except when Global tender enquiry has been issued.
New Clause 26.2 of Section-II	In terms of orders for Public Procurement (Performance to Make in India) the minimum local content shall be min. 50% for 'Class-I local supplier, min. 20% & <50% for 'Class-II, local suppliers & <20% for 'Non-local supplier and the margin of purchase preference shall be 20%.
New Clause 26.3 of Section-II	Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be terms as L1. If L1 is from a Class-I local supplier, the contract will be awarded to L1.
New Clause 26.4 of Section-II	If L1 is not Class-I local supplier, the lowest bidder among the Class-I local supplier, will be invited to match the L1 price subject to Class-I local supplier's quoted prices falling within the margin of purchase preference (L1+20%), and the contract shall be awarded to such Class-I local supplier subject to matching the L1 price
New Clause 26.5 of Section-II	In case such lowest eligible Class-I local supplier fails to match the L1 price, the Class-I local supplier with the next higher bid within the margin of purchase preference (L1+20%) shall be invited to match the L1 price and so on and contract shall be awarded accordingly. In case none of the Class-I local suppliers within the margin of purchase preference matches the L1 price, then the contract may be awarded to the L1 bidder
New Clause 26.6 of Section-II	The 'Class-I local supplier'/ 'Class-II local supplier shall be required to indicate percentage of local content and provide self-certification that the item offered meets the local content and shall give details of the location(s) at which the local value addition is made. In case of procurement for a value in excess of Rs. 10 Crores, the 'Class-I local supplier'/ 'Class-II local supplier' shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content.

Note:

1. All other terms & conditions of the tender shall remain unchanged.
2. This Corrigendum also forms part of the Tender Document and all the bidders are required to sign and submit the same along with the tender.

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
