## HIGHLIGHTS - CONCOR (DECEMBER 2024)

1. CONCOR established Rail connectivity for the Gati Shakti Multi-Modal Cargo Terminal (GCT) at Varnama with the Western Dedicated Freight Corridor (WDFC) at New Makarpura Yard. This milestone was marked by the arrival of the First Double-Stack Rake with 180 TEUs arrived from CMLK to CGMV.
2. CONCOR and Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya formalized a strategic partnership by signing an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 26.12.2024 to explore innovative Logistics Solutions based on the Academic Research of GSV to enhance the Logistics efficiency.
3. CONCOR's ICD /Dhandarikalan, Ludhiana (DICD) moved the first Block Rake (DICD-MDCC) of one of the world's leading shipping line- CMA CGM to Mundra, on 18th December, 2024. This Train is scheduled to run every Wednesday. Similar Block Train was also run in return direction i.e., from Mundra Port to DICD.
4. CONCOR's MMLP located at Mihan (Nagpur) successfully dispatched its maiden Container Train laden with Rice meant for exports to Chennai International Terminal Pvt. Ltd (CITPL) on 03.12.2024.
5. CONCOR successfully carried out 1st movement of perishable cargo in Ice Battery-fitted containers by sea from Chennai to Sri Vijayapuram (Port Blair) on 26.12.2024. The introduction of the ICE BATTERY containers is expected to address several logistical challenges that have long affected the Chennai-Port Blair shipping route.
6. CONCOR moved it's maiden Container Train with 90 containers, destined for ICD-Amingaon (Guwahati), laden with 'Granulated Slag' booked by M/s Tata Dureco, on 04.12.2024 from newly inaugurated MMLP-Jajpur (GCT GCCJ) located in Jajpur-District, Odisha.
